

PLAY IT SAFE!

Upon opening the course for play, while maintaining a safe environment for all guest and staff, these guidelines must be adhered to until PA Public Health or CDC advises otherwise. Other guidelines may be implemented based upon our needs as we go through this season.

Reserving a tee time:

- We request all tee time be paid in advance. If you have to cancel and refund is required, you can do so at the time of that cancelation process, with no surcharge being applied.
- Tee times and paying in advanced can be done by calling the golf shop at **717.641.7382**, or going online at www.mtviewgc.com and can be made up to 14 days
- Tee time will be set to 12-minute intervals.
- All reservations made include riding. If necessary, reservations/fees can be adjusted at time of check-in.
- Reservations of less than four may be paired with other golfers to fill out the foursome. You will be able to maintain a physical distance of at least 6' during your round. If you are not comfortable having a group join you, we encourage you to book and show up with four players.
- With the single player riding restrictions, there is the possibility riding cars may not be available right at your preferred tee time, particularly late morning or early afternoon, You should call the golf shop before arriving at the course, pull carts will be available as well with the same issue. No extra Golf cars will be permitted for anyone not playing or paying green fees

Checking In:

- We ask that you not arrive more than 15 minutes before your tee time.
- A maximum of 4 people including staff allowed in the clubhouse at any time. Do not congregate in or around the clubhouse.
- If you haven't paid online call the pro shop when you arrive at the course to pay for your fees by phone using credit, debit or Gift card. Cash will be accepted but we ask that you have correct amount.
- Guests MUST wear a face cover in/around the clubhouse and when interacting with staff. This can be a home-made face cover. Check the link to the CDC home page on how to make a home-made face cover. www.cdc.gov
- Restrooms in the clubhouse will be open and disinfected regularly, weather permitting, the doors to the clubhouse and bathrooms may be propped open when not in use.
- The practice green is open to guests 10 minutes prior to their tee time. It is closed to anyone without a tee time. Bumpers have been installed all flags/cups to prevent the ball from going in the cup, Please do not remove/touch. You may find an area to putt, provided you can maintain a distance of 6 feet.
- The driving range, chipping green and all other practice facilities will be closed to everyone until further notice.
- The pro shop will be closed to the public.
- Scorecards and pencils will NOT be placed on golf cars or available. We recommend keeping score on a mobile phone app, e.g. Easy Score Golf Scorecard

PLAY IT SAFE!

When you arrive to the course:

- Each group will be called to the tee. To maintain physical distancing DO NOT head to the first tee until it is completely clear your group is called.
- Physical distancing of at least 6' from everyone in your group and our staff MUST be adhered to at all times.
- Flagsticks always need to remain in the cup. A bumper is inserted 1.5 inch above cup to prevent ball from entering or the flag being pulled. When a ball hits the bumper, it is considered holed out.
- Avoid touching anyone else's golf equipment including golf car, bag, clubs, balls, tees, pull cart, etc.
- Bunker rakes, ball washers, water coolers, have been removed, you should bring your own prefilled water bottles. There will be no coolers on the course or ice/bottle fill stations in the clubhouse.
- On-course bathrooms will be closed.
- To avoid anyone else having to touch your trash, especially food items, we encourage you to hold on to all trash especially food items until the end of your round. At the end of your round deposit your trash into the properly marked trash and recycle bins around the clubhouse and cart barn.
- Golf cars pull carts and other equipment will be cleaned and disinfected after each use.
- **We recommend, for extra protection you should bring your own hand sanitizer and/or disinfectant wipes, mask, and any personal protective equipment you feel necessary.**

Food and Beverage Service:

- Food service will be **TO GO** only, with a limited menu. Call **717.641.7381** to place your order, when you arrive for your tee time, when you get to the **8th tee** or **18th tee** (if you desire to take it with you). Credit, debit and gift card preferred. Inform staff if you must use cash.
- Customers must limit their time in the grill and will not be permitted to congregate in groups. Please maintain the 6' physical distancing if you have to use the grill.
- Due to limited staffing, Snack bar hours may vary.

*If you are feeling well, symptom free and feel safe to golf, please come enjoy a round with us.
Our course will remain open if all CDC & PA Health guidelines are obeyed.*
